Egypt Trip Report

After months of prayer and planning and support raising our ministry trip to Egypt is now history. We feel the impact will be felt for quite some time, both by us and by those we met and spent time with.

We started off our time there with a day of tourist activities which included: a camel ride of a couple of hours out to the pyramids and back, a visit to the famous "Cave Church", and a tour of the awe inspiring Egypt Museum. It was truly amazing to see those works of art that were created thousands of years ago by unknown artists and methods.

We were hosted by Laila and Wahid Wahba, our ICM Country

Directors who also lead the Middle East Leadership Training Institute.

We spent a total of four days presenting our seminar on addiction recovery which included many one on one conversations and small group discussions.

We discovered that the majority of the churches in Egypt are not ready to face the issue of having to deal with addictions to pornography that is beamed into every home via the satellite dishes that adorn all the buildings or via the Internet that many have access to.

It became apparent that even though we were speaking to professional health care providers they had not had any experience in help-

ing those with this addiction issue to begin to be free of the addiction and begin healing.

We also spent a day in Alexandria with a group of Church of God pastors. Georgia was able to visit parts of that city while Dennis presented a one day seminar on the same topic of addiction. Many of those in attendance expressed a desire to learn more about how to help those addicted but there were a few that felt this was a topic that shouldn't be discussed openly.

The Closer You Get...By Georgia

The closer we got, the bigger they were. They looked big from a distance but standing right next to them, they completely filled my vision. There was nothing else to see but huge blocks of limestone: The pyramids; Cairo, Egypt. THE PYRAMIDS!! To see them in travel pictures is nothing in comparison to touching the rough, worn, 6000 year old surface. It's almost indescribable. The experience is a great analogy for something else that is beyond compare:

trying to grasp Who God is. The closer we get, the bigger He gets; He completely fills our vision as we stand next to Him. He is mysterious, timeless, and we can only comprehend small parts of Him. We can never see all of God all at the same time; only those bits He gives us in small doses. Fortunately, our understanding of Him is not necessary in order for us to have a relationship with Him.
