Rhonda and Kelley Phillips are the Regional Coordinators for Church of God Global Ministries in Europe and the Middle East. Some time ago, Rhonda wrote to Georgia about the possibility of us traveling to Chelyabinsk, Russia to do some teaching at the young church in that city.

Because of that possibility, we were in Anderson, Indiana in June to meet with Andrei Kolegov, one of the pastors from the Russian church and with Dwayne and Kara Goldman who are missionaries in that church involved in leadership training.

some missions related workshops in 2007. This year we were there to meet Pastor Andrei face to face and begin to make plans for a ministry trip to Chelyabinsk tentatively scheduled for November of this year.

We have now been formally invited to present some training on Christian living according to Biblical standards

and to offer some training on addiction recovery. We were told that 8 out of every 10 women in Russia have had at least one abortion and alcoholism is epidemic so we hope to offer some training in dealing with those issues. We invite you to pray that we would know specifically if we are to take on this assignment.

We were first introduced to what is known as “missions” when we traveled with our friends Steve and Jackie Scott back in 1989 to Crow Agency, Montana to do some work on the reservation there. Since then Georgia and/or Dennis have traveled to Mexico, Jamaica, India, Kenya, Uganda, Egypt, Taiwan, and Hong Kong and have spent hours in airports too many to mention as God led us to where we are now. We have had the opportunity to participate in and lead outreach teams overseas on ministry trips. What we have learned over the years we are now able to share with other church groups who are either going on STM trips or plan to in the future.

Recently, Dennis presented a short teaching on “How To” do STM trips at the Lynchwood Church of God in Portland. This church has an active missions group that is eager to raise the bar on what they do. It is always exciting for us to assist another church in any aspect of missions and outreach.

Dennis also presented a video and talk on adapting to different cultures to a group of students at Mt. Scott Church of God here in Portland. Aaron Walton the student ministries pastor recently returned from a trip to India and Bangladesh and is leading this group of young people to Vicente Guerrero in Mexico to work at the Welcome Home Orphanage. Aaron recognizes the need for preparing people of any age to realize that we Americans are in the minority and that other cultures do not function like our American culture. It was good to be with this group for an evening.
